One of my favorite verses in the Bible is Matthew 28:6, "He (Jesus) is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay."

One of the most famous Buddhist temples in the world is the Shwe Dagon. Embedded in the solid masonry of the base is a gold box which contains some finger-bones, teeth, and other parts of Buddha, who lived centuries ago.

A Columbarium is a collection of niches designed to house urns inscribed with the person's names and dates of birth and death.

The principal benefit a Columbarium affords church members and their families is the opportunity to select their final resting place in the shadow of the church where their loved ones can visit and meditate at any time.

The Columbarium is part of First Presbyterian Church and functions under the authority of the Session. A Columbarium Committee oversees operation of the Columbarium.

Gary Barton will be the guest organist.









## **AGAPE QUILTS**

## THE FUEL FUND

This month the Community Concerns and Missions Committee wants to spotlight the Fuel Fund. This fund grew out of discussions in a Sunday School class at FPC-Athens nearly 40 years ago. The "Fund" is not a budgeted item and has been funded by extra giving by FPC membership or by special gifts designated to support it.

Beneficiaries of the fund receive 25-75% of their fuel bill. Originally the fund was administered from our Church office. Recipients would come by the Church to produce their bills and get a check.

In an effort to have better screening and to serve a greater number of people in need, FPC has partnered with the Help Center for many years. The Help Center (a 501c-3 non-profit organization) has a much broader base and serves as a focal point in the Athens community to help those in need.


