## PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

My ponderings this month center around our country and the direction it seems to be headed. I believe it's time to focus our attention on Gods leadership and not ours.

The Lord is sovereign over all things, and He's the one who establishes nations and uproots them. In His eyes, they are as influential as "a drop from a bucket" or "a speck of dust on the scales" (Isa. 40:15). Have you ever thought of our country like this? From our perspective as individual citizens, nations wield great power and authority, and it seems as if one person would be unable to bring about any change.

But Christians can impact a nation with their prayers. In fact, the way we can play a part in reversing the downward trajectory of the nation is by interceding for those in authority. 


