- Many thanks to Donna Meredith for filling in as our church secretary. Donna will train Kelly Sasenbery to become our new church secretary/office administrator.
- There will be a new members reception on Sunday, August 27, 2023. It will be held in the Foyer/Atrium at 9:45 a.m.


