They've struck out before they step up to the plate.

The Gospel of Matthew touches on the subject of worry.

Beginning with Matthew 6:25-ff, we hear Jesus saying, "...Do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them.

In the Gospel of Matthew, the sixth chapter, Jesus shares with us exactly how we can avoid worry. "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you."
