## **PASTOR'S PONDERINGS**

Here's something I bet you've never heard of: "Jerry and David's Guide to the World Wide Web." It was a website put up in January 1994, by two Stanford University graduate students, Jerry Yang and David Filo. It was a directory of other websites – a way for users to discover the relatively small number of websites that existed in the early nineties. In April of 1994, the name was changed to Yahoo!, and in January 1995, the yahoo.com address was registered – and the era of seeking and finding on the Internet was born.

Yahoo!, as the main way to seek and find what's on the Internet, was eventually supplanted by Google as the leader in the digital search space. Today, finding information, people, news, and products couldn't be easier. Most Google searches are accomplished in less than a second. Searching, it seems like that's all we're doing these days – searching. The Magi searched for a new King of Israel with no certainty of finding Him. In God's plan, their search led them to a stable, in an obscure town. We enjoy the Christmas magic of knowing who Jesus is, where He is, and how we may know Him better.

Are you seeking Him this Christmas: in the Scriptures, in your daily journey, in sharing Him with others, in living a sacrificial life, and in serving Him with true worship? Those are the ways Christmas reminds us to seek and find Him. And what about gifts? What gifts do you bring Him this Christmas? Let your gifts be those of love, forgiveness, joy, worship, celebration, and a sacrificial life. We have found the Savior the Magi sought. Let us celebrate Him!

Kurt and Hyeyoung are involved on many levels in South Korea. Some of the areas of service include:



Kurt and Hyeyoung say their call to this work stems in part from their relationship with each other, which they believe reflects the value of working together across different cultures.




It's time for Christmas Benevolence and we are in need of volunteers!






